

<u>Citrix Access Gateway Server SSL Certificate Installation Steps:</u>

1. Copy and paste the Server Certificate (including the BEGIN and END tags) into a text editor such as Notepad and save it with a .crt extension.



2. From the Access Gateway Administration Tool, select the **Access Gateway Cluster** tab and then open the window for the Access Gateway.
