


Install The Intermediate And Root Certificate In MMC

Import Intermediate Certificate using MMC

Step 1: Open MMC

To open MMC (Microsoft Management Console), go to Run (Win+R), type mmc & click OK



Step 2: Access Add or Remove Snap-Ins

In MMC, click on File & select the option 'Add/Remove Snap-in'
